Delaying BIRT and NPT payments to the City of Philadelphia previously scheduled with Modern e-Filing (MeF) software

Taxpayers and preparers can reschedule Business Income & Receipts Tax (BIRT) and Net Profits Tax (NPT) payments. You can reschedule your payment to any date no later than July 15, 2020, but MUST SUBMIT A REQUEST BY APRIL 10, 2020.

To reschedule a payment, select the link below, and complete and submit the online form by 5 p.m., April 10, 2020.
